



Political Debate Guidelines

The MN Channel will consider co-producing issue or candidate debates with partners as long as the programs do not promote a particular perspective on an issue. The programs must be, in perception and reality, absolutely neutral in their approach.

Therefore, for these programs we expect that our partners will work with us to recommend the broad design of the event, including location, date, time, length and general content areas to be covered.

Once an agreement is reached, **tpt** will determine the specific elements of the event, including host(s), format, participants and specific questions.

While we believe that all of our partners are as committed to editorial integrity as we are, we also believe that this separation of roles is critical to assuring viewers and candidates that key decisions regarding debates are made by absolutely neutral parties.
