# PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

As you may have heard by now, TPT launched a new 24/7 PBS Kids channel on Monday, January 16. Using the power of media to educate and inspire children has been part of our DNA since Twin Cities PBS was founded 60 years ago. This new 24/7 children's service raises and redoubles our commitment. Now, any time of the day, or night – whether sitting in a living room, or in a car – children and families will have access to the best that television can offer to our most precious resource – children. Here are some questions I have been asked recently about the new service.

## What is the new PBS Kids channel?

The new 24/7 PBS Kids channel is a new television channel we launched on January 16 and can be received free over the air and on cable. It will also be “streamed” live on the internet! Now, children can watch anywhere they have an internet or phone connection.

## Why is TPT offering a 24/7 PBS Kids channel?

Prior to creating this new service, we were only able to devote certain hours of our broadcast schedule to children. We had to share our channels with adult programming as well. Not anymore! Data shows that live TV is the primary way children access video. Most kids' TV viewing takes place on weeknights, and on weekend afternoons and evenings. This trend is true for all children, but especially for those in low-income families. We want our programming to be available to the kids who need it most at the times and in the ways that they are able to access our content.

## Will the PBS Kids channel only be available on my TV?

No. The PBS Kids channel will be available on-air AND online. TPT will now be able to broadcast PBS KIDS shows 24 hours a day on an additional television channel and to offer a live stream so that children can watch their favorite shows whenever they want, wherever they are.

## Will PBS Kids shows still air on Channel 2?

Yes! There are no immediate changes planned for the current lineup of PBS Kids on TPT 2. Daytime programming on TPT 2 will still include your child's favorite PBS Kids programming. This new channel will provide us the opportunity to show more of your favorite PBS programs by offering them across multiple channels.

## How can I watch the new PBS Kids channel?

The PBS Kids channel is available over-the-air on TPT's channel 2-4 (TPT-WX has moved to 2-5), and via cable providers, as well as online at [pbskids.org](http://pbskids.org).

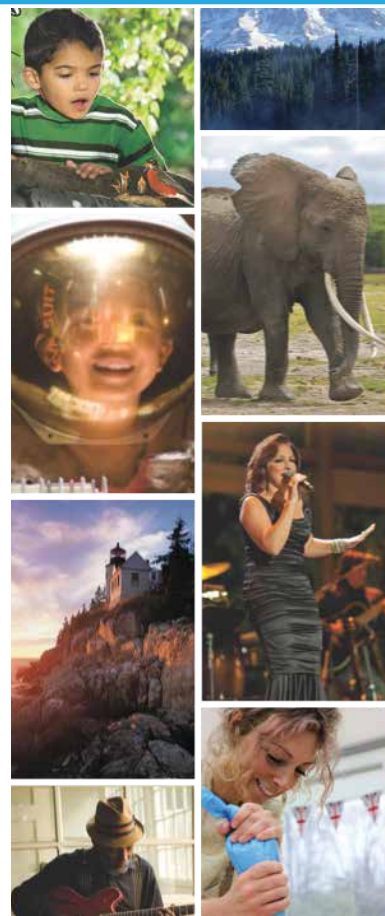

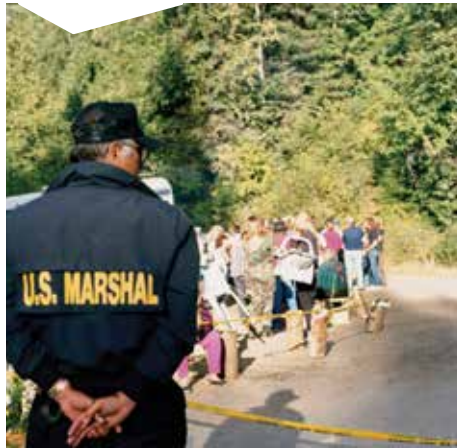
